Property Summary

South of Brady, NE sits a true sportsman's paradise. With 1,460± contiguous acres of hard canyon pasture land, this property is filled with elk, deer, wild turkey, and dove. There is excellent access via Callahan Road. Sections 1 and 2 are registered elk zones with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission. The Sellers feel section 36 could also be given an elk zone tag. This would provide the full 1,460± acres with elk hunting opportunities. An out of state owner could apply for a resident or nonresident elk tag, conditional upon approval from the Nebraska Game and Parks.

The hardland canyon pasture is perfect for grazing cattle. In 2022, 135 pairs were grazed due to the drought, but in prior years, as many as 180 pairs were grazed for 5 months. The property is available for the 2023 cattle grazing season, and will remain open for the 2023 grazing season.

There are 3 water sources and 1 tank. The tank water source comes from a mutual agreement with the neighbor to the west of Callahan Road. It is a year-to-year arrangement with no future guarantees; however, the neighbor is cooperative to sharing the water that flows underneath Callahan Road. There is electrical power on the property via a submersible well located in Section 1.

This property presents a great chance to purchase hunting and grazing land in Eastern Lincoln County.







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SOIL MAP

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
